ABSTRACT

This introductory World Cultures course provides a fun, interactive experience for a student's first exposure to the Spanish language. The content for each unit is based on an authentic story, myth or legend from Spanish-speaking culture. This course, designed specifically for younger students, focuses principally on vocabulary acquisition through stories, games, songs, and practice activities. Students are exposed to Spanish language and Spanish-speaking cultures in a fun environment where they can explore meanings and begin to express themselves through simple words and phrases.

This K-2 World Cultures course helps students engage in language learning; understand and produce common vocabulary terms and phrases; interpret meaning from authentic fables and stories, and, compare cultural practices and perspectives of Spanish-speaking communities. Each unit begins with an authentic story presented entirely in Spanish that introduces key vocabulary and a cultural theme. These stories originate from Spanish-speaking fables and tales from Mexico, Spain, and Latin America. Essential questions and enduring understandings within the K-2 course focus on understanding the role language plays in communication as well as understanding the basic acquisition of a cultural perspective.
